

## COMMUNITY NOTICE: July 10, 2009



Amaizeingly Green Products, L.P. has made significant progress towards the completion of its odour abatement plan in recent weeks due to the robust supply of local engineering and construction services, and the rapid delivery of all odour abatement and ancillary equipment.

As a result, we expect that all odour abatement equipment will be fully installed next week. We will continue toward the completion of the remaining projects keeping environmental protection and safety at the forefront.

We are proud of the diligent effort our operators, engineers and the contractors have put into the implementation of the plan. We are happy to report that even in the face of a difficult manufacturing environment, no employees have been laid off during this period of non-production and that the voluntary shutdown is allowing us to perform extensive preventative maintenance on critical equipment and to clean our plant to a pristine condition.

With regard to noise abatement measures, a silencer has been installed on a piece of equipment that emits a gasping, rush-like noise (referred to technically as an "impulse" noise) on top of one of our silos. It is projected that the silencer, installed on a voluntary basis, will decrease the noise emitted from this source by more than half.

We are excited and confident that our odour abatement plan, when fine-tuned and fully commissioned, will be the platform for a fresh new start for our relationships with the local community.
