

## COMMUNITY STATUS REPORT: June 26, 2009



Amaizeingly Green Products, L.P. (formerly Collingwood Ethanol, L.P.) is making significant progress on its odour abatement plan, which is expected to be completed this summer.

The engineering (i.e. the planning and design) of our odour abatement installations is 100 per cent complete and the majority of equipment procured will be on site this week. Fabrication continues on the larger ductwork and equipment so that it is ready to be installed during our shutdown period.

We initiated the processes to commence our facility-wide shutdown last week, which began with inventory reduction in all interior process tanks. With environmental protection and safety at the forefront, this process will systematically continue until the facility achieves a complete shutdown at the end of June. The voluntary shutdown will allow us to install the new odour abatement equipment and to complete the remaining projects outlined in our odour abatement plan.

To date, of the 28 odour abatement projects initiated under our odour abatement plan, 16 have been addressed and implementation of the 12 remaining projects will begin shortly. Given the current state of the economic climate in Ontario, we were able to secure the services of many engineering and construction firms sooner than expected and with little notice, so implementation of our projects has been expedited.

With regards to our noise abatement measures, our follow-up acoustic audit report will be submitted to the Ministry of the Environment (MOE) in the upcoming weeks and additional noise abatement equipment is on order and scheduled for installation.
