



COMMUNITY UPDATE: July 17, 2009



Dear Neighbour,

On July 15 we provided an update to you on our progress in addressing odour sources in our plant. That update indicated that we were well ahead of schedule because the economic slowdown has created a unique situation where both construction labour and needed equipment were readily available. Over the past several days we have been in discussions with the Ministry of the Environment to confirm that we have met all their requirements.

In accordance with ministry requirements and our own commitment to open communications with our neighbours, we are providing notification to you that we will restart our production facilities on July 20 at 8:00am.

We are very proud of the effort put forth by our employees to perform extensive preventative maintenance on critical equipment and to clean our plant to a pristine condition during our voluntary shutdown and we are confident that the new abatement equipment we have installed will help restore a good relationship with our neighbours. An important part of the process of completing our odour abatement plan has been to provide regular updates to you, our neighbours, to inform you of our progress and to be available to answer your questions. This is a practice we will continue through our startup and into the future.

We are absolutely committed to being the best neighbor we can be.
