***Amaizeingly Green Begins Plant Shutdown***

**Collingwood, Ontario, June 22, 2009** - Amaizeingly Green Products, L.P. (formerly Collingwood Ethanol, L.P.) today announced the commencement of the facility-wide shutdown, which is being done to complete remaining processes and engineering installations outlined in the company's odour abatement plan. The process began this weekend with the inventory reduction in all in-house process tanks and will systematically continue until the facility achieves a complete shutdown at the end of June.

"A facility-wide shutdown is a huge undertaking, but we feel it is worth it if it means we are going to quickly and effectively complete the rest of the odour abatement measures," said Martin Kazmir, General Manager, Amaizeingly Green. "We are committed to improving our green footprint in the community and we feel we've been making significant progress on our plan."

Last Friday, the company pleaded guilty to two charges laid by the Ministry of the Environment for adverse affects to the community that were primarily the result of mechanical failure of the company's waste water treatment plant. The company also pleaded guilty to another charge which related to the operation of a piece of equipment that was not identified in the company's Certificate of Approval, which is being rectified. In total, the company paid \$340,000 in fines as part of the settlement.

"We had some issues when we first began operations, and while we are happy to have put those behind us with the settlement of this legal issue, we're proud of what we are doing now," said Martin Kazmir. "We look forward to a long and bright future operating in a responsible way in the community to produce and supply ethanol, and to continue with the production and delivery of other environmentally-friendly products such as our line of chemical-free fertilizers."
