AMAIZEINGLY GREEN ENTERS STABILIZATION PHASE OF PLANT START-UP

Collingwood, Ontario, July 28, 2009 – Having completed the first 10 days of the plant start-up protocol, Amaizeingly Green Products, L.P. (AGP) - *formerly Collingwood Ethanol, L.P.* - today confirmed the company has now entered the stabilization phase of the process. The Ministry of the Environment (MOE) has received and accepted the start-up protocol and continues to work closely with AGP to track progress.

During the stabilization phase, AGP will be fine-tuning operations and processes to achieve a steady state where output volumes meet operating targets and quality specifications. The plant will be deemed to have reached a stable state when targets and quality specifications have been achieved for a continual period of 72 hours.

“We have been working closely with the MOE to ensure that we are doing our due diligence and following a systematic process to ensure everything is working the way it should be,” said Martin Kazmir, General Manager, AGP. “We are committed to getting things right and we will take any action necessary to address issues that could arise during such a lengthy and complex process.”

On July 27th, AGP proactively shut the plant down when a number of complaints about odours suggested that something in the process may have been malfunctioning. The detailed assessment of operational logs and records did not turn up anything that indicated a problem. Once it was determined that there were no abnormalities, the plant resumed operations and the start-up protocol continued.

“We have received complaints about noise and odours, both when we were operating and after we had shut the plant down yesterday,” said Kazmir. “Our assessments yesterday (Monday) were unable to show that AGP had been the source of the odour that resulted in complaints. We continue to follow our complaint response process.” The MOE will continue with on-going, independent noise and odour assessments and will be in the area over the next several weeks to perform tests to evaluate the plant as AGP moves through the stabilization phase.

With respect to noise, an acoustic audit and peer review was submitted to the MOE. Both documents - which have yet to be reviewed by the MOE - determined that the noise emanating from the facility was below the daytime and nighttime limits.

“We are committed to continually look for areas where we can improve our environmental footprint and to ensure that we are keeping our stakeholders and the community informed of progress and any issues that may arise,” said Kazmir. “We are confident that the investments we have made and the hard work we have been doing will have a positive outcome for our company and the community.”
