Amaizeingly Green to Establish Community Liaison Committee

Collingwood, Ontario, August 25, 2009 – Amaizeingly Green Products, L.P. (AGP) today confirmed that the company will establish a Community Liaison Committee (CLC) as part of its commitment to building and maintaining an open two-way dialogue with the community.

“Essentially this committee would be an expanded and refocused version of the community-based committee that met during the first two years of the facility’s operations,” said Martin Kazmir, General Manager, AGP. “This is another step we are taking to ensure not only that we are sharing information with members of the community and other important stakeholders, but that we are hearing what they have to say.”

The goal of the CLC will be to assist AGP in its efforts to:

- Assess the ongoing social and environmental impacts of the AGP plant;
- Review and comment on air and noise quality reports, technical studies, social responsibility issues and other matters of interest to the community;
- Identify and address any impacts of the AGP facility operations and to develop measures to monitor and mitigate these impacts; and,
- Examine and comment on site operations, monitoring programs, community engagement and public concerns.

The composition of the committee will include a resident, or residents of the area immediately surrounding the facility site, representatives of the Town of Collingwood, the Ontario Ministry of the Environment, the local Chamber of Commerce, local business professionals and a representative from Amaizeingly Green.

With regards to the odour abatement plan, implementation is now complete and AGP has initiated its baseline odour testing program.

“Our baseline odour testing program will enable us to determine if we achieved what we set out to do in our plan and to determine if further action is required,” said Kazmir. “We expect to complete this program by the end of August.”

During a portion of the baseline odour testing program, AGP will suspend the use of Ecolo – an environmentally-safe additive that is being using on a trial basis in AGP’s scrubbers.

“While this may result in a temporary change in odours emanating from our facility, ceasing the use of Ecolo is required in order to properly assess the effectiveness of the abatement measures taken and to further refine plant operations as necessary,” said Kazmir.

The Ecolo product uses only food-grade, edible essential oils similar to those contained in many ecologically-friendly consumer products. AGP is working with HLS Ecolo to optimize the formulation and dose rates to safely target and reduce emissions.

Last week AGP experienced a minor setback in the testing program when a fan imbalance was discovered in the pellet mill operation. AGP shutdown the pellet mill process and it will remain down until the problem is corrected, which is expected to occur by the middle of this week.
