AMAIZEINGLY GREEN PROVIDES NOTICE OF PELLETT MILL RE-START

Collingwood, Ontario, August 14, 2009 – Amaizeingly Green Products, L.P. (AGP) today notified the Ontario Ministry of the Environment (MOE) and local residents that it anticipates re-starting its pellet mill operations on Monday, August 17th.

As part of its odour abatement plan and as reviewed by the MOE, AGP has performed a significant amount of work to turn the pellet mill system into a closed-loop process in order to eliminate emissions (both particulate and odour). Previously, when a pellet was made, it was dropped into a chamber where it was cooled with outside air, and then the air was expelled to the atmosphere. The new closed-loop system passes heated air from the cooling chamber through a chiller and re-uses it, while particulate is also recycled back into the process.

“We are very excited about re-starting the pellet mill,” said Martin Kazmir, General Manager of AGP. “It is a very important piece of the process used to make our Amaizeingly Green natural and ecologically-friendly fertilizer, and now that we have installed processes to make it odour and particulate-emission free, it is truly an environmentally-friendly product.”

Upon startup, AGP will work to stabilize operations of the pellet mill in order to achieve a steady state of the mill’s rated output and quality specifications.

“Once stabilized, we will do a thorough evaluation of the pellet mill to ensure that there are no emissions escaping from the new system,” said Kazmir. “Our goal is to perform this evaluation as we conduct our baseline odour sampling program of the whole facility. That way we can assess the effectiveness of our odour abatement plan in its entirety.”

The baseline odour sampling program is expected to commence during the week of August 17th.
