



## COMMUNITY UPDATE: July 15, 2009



Amaizeingly Green Products, L.P. (formerly Collingwood Ethanol, L.P.) has essentially completed its odour and noise abatement projects and is currently in discussions with the Ministry of the Environment to wrap up some final details to ensure that we will fully comply with all ministry requirements and meet our commitments to the community. Subject to the ministry's confirmation, we expect to be able to start the plant up during the week of July 20.

As we prepared for our voluntary shut-down in June, it became clear that the ready availability of equipment and construction labour would allow us to substantially accelerate the pace of the work. We are pleased that we were able to complete the projects quickly without having to lay off any of our plant staff. Despite having completed the work ahead of schedule, we have taken extreme care to ensure that we got it right and expect that the ministry will be able to concur later this week that we fully comply with their requirements.

We are very excited about turning the page and showing Amaizeingly Green to be a good corporate citizen and an innovative green industry. We have developed a diverse range of eco-friendly products and will be providing more information about them in future newsletters.

We are confident that our recently-installed odour and noise abatement equipment will be the platform for a fresh new start for our relationships with the local community.
