



COMMUNITY STATUS REPORT: June 12, 2009

Amaizeingly Green Products, L.P. (formerly Collingwood Ethanol, L.P.) is now fully engaged in its odour abatement plan to be completed this summer. As part of this process, Amaizeingly Green will deliver status reports to the local community every two weeks. In the future, these status reports will be available on our website (www.amaizeinglygreen.com/community).

Engineering of all odour abatement projects is progressing well and is almost 90% complete. Project notifications have been sent to all the appropriate regulatory agencies, and most long lead-time items have been ordered and are expected to be on-site shortly.

Some of the less complex abatement projects are complete and have shown a promising effect. In addition, we have modified some procedures at the facility to keep certain fugitive-type odours to a minimum. We will initiate our facility-wide shutdown on June 19th and will systematically continue until the facility achieves a complete shutdown at the end of June.

Prior to shutdown, we will complete a follow-up acoustic audit to gauge the effectiveness of recently-installed noise abatement equipment. As well, we expect to install additional noise abatement items during our shutdown.

Amaizeingly Green apologizes for any inconvenience we may have caused the community. We will hold a tour of the facility during the shutdown so members of the public can witness our progress. The date of this tour will be given in our next status report, two weeks from today.
